VISITOR INFORMATION SACRAMENTO CAMPUS - COVID SAFETY PROCEDURES



In response to rising cases of COVID-19 driven by the highly contagious <u>Delta variant</u>, the state of California's public health department has ordered new visitor requirements. We are limiting visitors in UC Davis Medical Center to help keep the COVID-19 out of the hospital. This care decision was made in an effort to protect our patients, staff and community.



PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU ARRIVE AT THE SACRAMENTO CAMPUS

Visitors will be allowed entrance to UC Davis Health facilities based on the following exceptions:

- Complete the <u>online screening survey</u> before entering the building with the required proof of vaccination or negative test documents.
- Individuals who are fully vaccinated must provide proof of full vaccination against COVID-19. If you
 cannot find your proof of vaccination, the <u>state health department's vaccine record portal website</u> may
 be helpful. To be considered fully vaccinated, you must have completed a COVID-19 vaccination series
 more than 2 weeks ago.
- Visitors who are unvaccinated or partially vaccinated must show documentation of a negative SARS-CoV-2 test, with the specimen collected within 72 hours before each visit. Those individuals may use either PCR or antigen testing. Sacramento County has an <u>online resource for testing locations and</u> information.
- In all cases, **visitors are only allowed if they do not have symptoms of illness** (such as fever, runny nose, cough, shortness of breath).
- Masks must be worn covering both the nose and mouth for the entire time and length of the visit.
- You may remove your face covering briefly to eat or take a quick drink.
- The GSM is providing hand sanitizing stations throughout the suite for your convenience.

Our goal in introducing these visitor restrictions is to protect you, your loved ones, other patients in the hospital and our staff. Patient and public safety are always our top priorities. Thank you again for your understanding during this difficult time.
