

# GSM FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ON COVID SAFETY

## VACCINATED EMPLOYEES

### 1. Do I need to be tested regularly if I am vaccinated?

Fully vaccinated and boosted individuals are still required to **test at least every 14 days** to gain access to university-controlled facilities.

### 2. Do I need to wear a mask/face covering while on campus?

Effective Saturday, March 19, face coverings will no longer be required in most indoor settings. Masks are still strongly recommended by our public health officials and by UC Davis for vaccinated, unvaccinated, and vulnerable populations.

### 3. Do I still need to complete the Daily Symptom Survey every time I go to campus, even if it is an off-site location?

Yes, an approval of the **Daily Symptom Survey** is still required.

### 5. How often do I need to test if I do not have a booster vaccine?

Those who are overdue for a booster shot will be required to **test every four days**. All eligible UC Davis affiliates are required to submit proof of booster vaccination to the [HEM system](#).

## UNVACCINATED EMPLOYEES

### 1. Do I need to be tested regularly if I am unvaccinated?

Yes, unvaccinated individuals and those who are overdue for a booster shot must **test regularly at least once every four days** and obtain a DSS approval prior to entering any campus facility throughout California even if the space is not owned or leased by campus.

### 2. Do I need to wear a mask/face covering while on campus?

Effective Saturday, March 19, face coverings will no longer be required in most indoor settings. Masks are still strongly recommended by our public health officials and by UC Davis for vaccinated, unvaccinated, and vulnerable populations.

### 3. Do I still need to complete the Daily Symptom Survey every time I go to campus, even if it is an off-site location?

Yes, an approval of the Daily Symptom Survey is still required until further notice.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ON EVENT GUIDANCE

## 1. Do I need to submit a proposal for my event even if my event is off-campus (San Ramon, SF, Sacramento or alternate location ie. Restaurant, Starbucks, etc)?

Yes. You need to submit a [GSM Event Safety Plan](#) to [Christina Sanchez](#) to ensure proper safety guidelines are being followed. Event proposals are not required for one-on-one meetings or meetings with less than 10 attendees.

## 2. Are masks required for my event?

Effective Saturday, March 19, face coverings will no longer be required in most indoor settings on the Sacramento and Davis campuses. Masks are still strongly recommended by our public health officials and by UC Davis for vaccinated, unvaccinated, and vulnerable populations.

## 3. Do my guests/visitors have to complete a Daily Symptom Survey?

Yes, all guests/visitors accessing campus facilities must complete the **DSS** prior to entrance. The host of the event will check these upon entrance into the facility or event venue. The survey can be accessed by scanning or clicking the QR codes located at the bottom of this page. Guests/visitors may be potential students, donors, vendors or GSM affiliates, anyone not receiving a paycheck or enrolled in courses. If you are serving food indoors with an event of 100 or more attendees, please note that non-affiliates must show their CDC Vaccine Card (phone image acceptable), digital vaccine record from the State of California, or negative COVID-19 test result from the last 72-hours. (This must be a lab/PCR test; home tests/antigen tests are not valid).

## 5. Do I need to maintain an attendee list?

It is good to maintain an attendee list and **verify DSS survey results upon entrance** to your event.

## 6. How do I know who is vaccinated or unvaccinated and whether they are required to wear masks?

Using the DSS survey approval upon entrance will help in identifying vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals. As of July 28, campus has ordered a mask mandate for all individuals regardless of vaccination status due to rising COVID cases.

## 7. Do I need special cleaning supplies or other supplies to ensure COVID safety for my event?

No, you do not need special cleaning supplies. However, cleaning supplies are available, please contact the [PIRO staff](#) at your location to obtain any supplies you may need. The GSM will also provide individually wrapped disposable masks for any attendees that need a mask. Make sure hand sanitizer is also available throughout your event location.
