- One space after a period.
- Do not use a serial comma unless necessary for clarity.
  - > She studied finance, marketing and business ethics.
  - > The GSM offers immersions in CFO for Technology, Sustainable Energy, Biotechnology, and Food and Agriculture (use comma in this instance to set apart the last compound phrase in the series).
- Capitalize sparingly. Lowercase in body copy.

- When first citing most acronyms, spell out the entire name immediately followed by the acronym in parentheses:
  - > The UC Davis Graduate School of Management (GSM)
