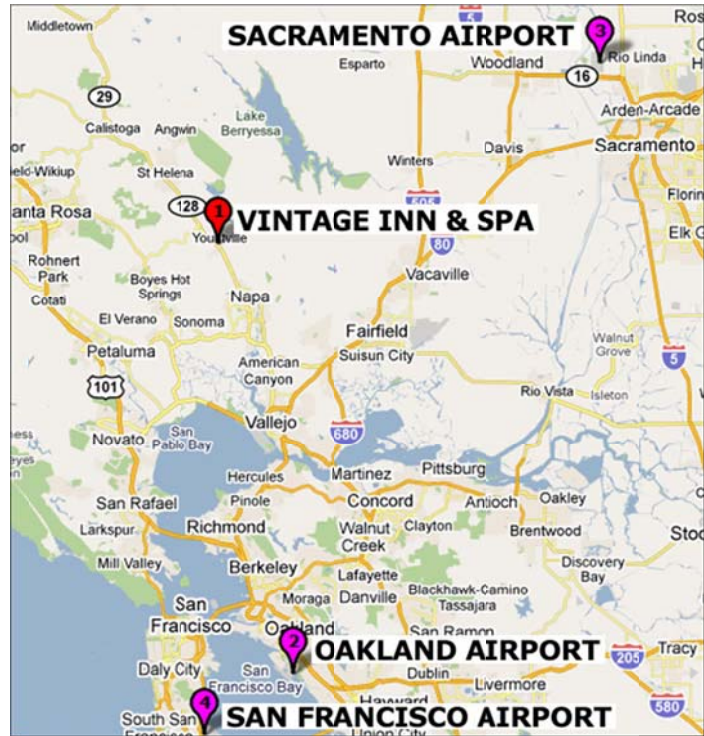


Airport Information for Napa Conference 2011

Traveling to Napa Valley
